**Scouting** – Our program offers many activities that develop character, citizenship and service throughout the school, parish and Silver Spring community. Open to school and parish members.

**Altar Servers** – Training is held most years for school and parish children in grades 5 and above.

**Art Horizons** – A favorite after-school enrichment program offered a few times a year. Clear some space on the walls, you will want to frame much of what they create in this great program!

**Girls on the Run** – Girls in grades 3–5 learn about navigating the pressures of today in a fun, active way. The girls learn they can do anything they set their minds to by preparing for and running a 5K.

**Foreign Language Club** – Focus is on language and culture in a really fun environment.

**Math Club** – Look for details to come home with students in grades 4–8.

**Safety Patrol** – Sixth Grade students are trained to help aid all students in safe arrival and departure from school each day. Promotes leadership and helps ensure safety of all students.

**School Band** – Offered to SJE students from grades 4-8. Students in grades 5-8 are eligible for the Advanced Band. Band is usually on Wednesdays (you may need to remind your child to bring their instrument!). Performances are usually given in December and May.

**Student Council** – Fosters leadership, academics, a sense of service to the school and fellow students as well as building school spirit.
